The Board meets together with the Dharma Council for business matters once a month. In addition, the board members work outside of board meetings leading committees or working on various projects, contributing their educational, management, legal and financial skills to ensure the long-term organizational stability of the DDC. Most board members spend 5-10 hours per month fulfilling Board related tasks and attending the monthly 2-3 hour meeting. The board encourages diversity and seeks applicants of all backgrounds.
